L. Summary of my Activities and Future Plans

I currently work as a Research Coordinator for the nursing staff at Galilee Medical Center, after having established research as a goal for nurses at the hospital and harnessing the nursing management to promote clinical research as part of day-to-day nursing practice. My purpose has been to increase scientific curiosity among the nursing staff as well as the level of nursing care at our medical center, which is located in Israel's periphery, to improving the hospitalization experience of patients with diverse cultural backgrounds.

Today I continue to lead multi-center research with hospitals from the periphery such as Ziv Medical Center and Poriya Medical Center, and hospitals in the center of the country such as Hadassah Ein Kerem, to promote joint research on traumatization among nursing and medical staff in maternity wards in Israel, including a study on sleep disorder among shift workers with short rest periods and its effect on the life of the couple and the family.

This year, I joined the Research Committee at the Nursing Department in order to advance research at the Simulation Center and to reduce social distance among Arab and Jewish students at times of crisis, with the purpose of raising Jewish-Arab cooperation at the Nursing Department, specifically, and in the periphery, in general.

In the near future, together with the Quality Unit of the Galilee Medical Center, and lecturers at Emek Yisrael College and Haifa University, we will strive to promote studies on the importance of an organizational learning environment for a culture of patient safety and improvement of team intentions to report almost-mistakes and actual reporting in addition to

research on the quality of treatment in the elderly population during hospitalization with emphasis on the doctrine of patient-family centered care.
