#### **F. Summary of my Activities and Future Plans**

In the past year, I assumed the role of Head of the Cheryl Spencer BA Nursing Science Department at The Max Stern Yezreel Valley College, while continuing my position as a Senior Lecturer with tenure. In this significant role, I lead a department with approximately 600 students and dozens of faculty members, combining academic management with strategic planning, curriculum development, and my ongoing research and teaching activities in health promotion and nursing education. This leadership role has presented unique challenges during the current wartime period, requiring careful balance between maintaining academic continuity and supporting students serving in reserve duty or essential positions, while fostering departmental resilience during national crisis.

My research focuses on two main areas: health promotion and nursing education innovation. In health promotion, I investigate health behaviors and risk factors, particularly among young women, using mixed-methods approaches. Recent projects include several evaluation studies for the Ministry of Health with grants totaling over 300,000 NIS. These include a comprehensive assessment of a new national tele-nursing call center for young families (112,000 NIS grant from NIHP), evaluation of school health services, and assessment of

pregnancy follow-up programs in the Haifa district. My research on COVID-19's impact on minority and elderly populations in Israel resulted in five published papers and contributed to understanding pandemic effects on vulnerable groups.

Currently, I am co-leading with my colleagues a project evaluating health promotion partnerships in the Galilee and Valleys Cluster (two grants totaling ~170,000 NIS, 2024-2026), focusing on ecological processes in health and nutrition. Additionally, my colleagues and I submitted a proposal to examine wellbeing and resilience from individual to community levels among cluster settlements, and we recently submitted a research proposal to the Israel Science Foundation exploring the impact of endometriosis on Jewish and Arab women's life course from a cross-cultural perspective.

In nursing education, I have been involved in describing and evaluating a unique departmental program designed to enhance mentalization capabilities, interpersonal and intrapersonal communication skills, and prevent professional burnout among nursing students and nurses. This work, which documented the program's implementation, resulted in a publication in the *Journal of Professional Nursing*. We are currently engaged in evaluating and developing the program for future enhancement. Additionally, we completed research on cultural intelligence and social distance among Jewish and Arab nursing students, with findings recently published. We are planning a follow-up study examining how these dynamics change in the context of current events.

My teaching responsibilities span undergraduate and graduate levels, including courses in health promotion fundamentals, qualitative research methods, and an advanced MA course "Nursing as a Health Promotion Leader - Advanced Models." As Department Head, I chair the Admissions Committee and have served on multiple committees including Teaching (former Chair), and Research Committee (former Chair).

Professional activities include serving as an editorial board member for "Health Promotion in Israel" and reviewing for international journals including *BMC Public Health*, *Frontiers in Public Health*, *Scientific Reports*, and *Healthcare*. I am a member of the Israeli Association for Research in Nursing and the Israeli Association of Public Health Physicians. Over the past two years, I received mobility grants facilitating collaboration with the International Hellenic University in Thessaloniki, Greece, where I delivered invited lectures and established partnerships for future research and teaching exchanges.

Recognition for my work includes the Best Poster Award at the 14th Annual National Conference on Health Policy (2022). I balance publishing in high-ranking international journals with contributions to Israeli publications to ensure research accessibility to field practitioners.

Looking ahead, I plan to continue developing research in health promotion and nursing education, submit major grant proposals, and strengthen both local and international collaborations. As Department Head, I am committed to advancing our curriculum, supporting faculty development, and mentoring the next generation of nursing professionals while maintaining active involvement in regional and global health initiatives.
