H. Summary of my Activities and Future Plans

H1. Research

I deal with interdisciplinary questions of socioeconomic policy design and analysis of policy implications among older adults, with emphasis on assuring social security for the purpose of coping with poverty and inequality among older adults; economic mobility and employment stability among low-wage earners; employment patterns and assurance of welfare among older adults; and research into policy on funding of health and welfare services and its effect on inequality among disempowered population groups.

I completed doctoral studies at the Eitan Berglas School of Economics at Tel Aviv University with Professor Daniel Tsiddon as my advisor. My dissertation centered on the question of disempowered population groups' employment mobility and survival in the Israeli labor market at a time of security uncertainty. While pursuing my studies, I was a senior researcher at the Division of the Chief Scientist of the Israel Central Bureau of Statistics, where I focused on a series of research topics involving income disparities and inequality, employment stability, and poverty among older adults. Afterwards, I completed two rounds of post-doctoral studies. The first took place at the Israel Gerontological Data Center, an auspice of the Paul Baerwald School of Social Work and Welfare (the Hebrew University of Jerusalem). My research there related to three main topics: welfare and public responsibility for financial and pension resources among older adults, employment and early retirement patterns among older adults, and government and private responsibility for the assurance of healthcare services. After completing this term of post-doctoral studies, I began my second post-doc specialization at the University of Rochester Medical Center School of Nursing in New York, USA. My research at this time concerned health inequality and social welfare among low-back-pain patients. While there, I was invited to be a visiting research at I.N.R.C.A., the National Institute of Health and Science on Ageing, in Ancona,

Italy, where I completed a study on long-term care in conjunction with a team of senior researchers at the institute.

After completing this second post-doctoral appointment, I became a visiting research associate at the University of Rochester Medical Center School of Nursing in New York, USA. My current research there focuses on social and economic aspects of addiction to opioids among adults. I am also a policy fellow at the Forum of Social Welfare Policy, the Forum of Health Policy, and the Forum of Labor Policy at the Taub Center of Social Policy Studies in Israel, as well as an editorial board member of the *Social Security* journal.

In my research, I probe a series of topics related to the design of welfare and socioeconomic policy with emphasis on socially disempowered population groups. The core interest in my work is an attempt to strengthen policy on funding healthcare and welfare services and its effect on poverty and social inequality among older adults. In addition to the series of topics that I dealt with in my post-doctorate studies, my research in recent years has focused on an attempt to understand transitions in welfare and labor force participations of persons with disabilities; transitions in poverty, standard of living and inequality among older adults; the role attributed to welfare, health, and demography in employment transitions in advanced age; assurance of older adults' welfare solidarity under various welfare regimes in Europe; factors that explain the continuance or cessation of social and economic assistance to elder kin, and the behavior of members of the "sandwich generation" in respect of long-term social and economic responsibility for their parents and children.

My main research interests at the present time and in the next few years are the following:

a. Financial Gerontology:

- a. The social and economic implications of retirement processes as such, as well as early retirement and return to the labor force. In view of the upturn in life expectancy and the need to assure an adequate standard of living in advanced age, it is important to understand the array of factors that explain people's decision to remain in the labor force after retirement age, retire before reaching retirement age, or re-enter the labor force after retiring upon reaching retirement age. In this study, I will investigate the social, health, and economic implications of individuals' patterns of activity, with emphasis on concern about the exacerbation of economic disparities and unplanned impoverishment.
- b. Voluntary and involuntary retirement processes—bolstering knowledge of social and government policy for the assurance of social security and prevention of overexposure in the probability of impoverishment and exacerbation of inequality due to voluntary and involuntary retirement processes, including comparisons among socioeconomic strata and employment characteristics. My research into these topics will expand to study of the foreseen implications of raising the formal retirement age on retirement processes and the implication of this policy change for the level of welfare and disparities among different social groups.
- c. Welfare policy as a function of raising the retirement age.
- d. The relation among timing of retirement, substitution ratio, and takeup of pension entitlements - What lessons should the welfare system learn?

b. Poverty and social security (among older adults):

- a. Poverty, inequality, and social security among disempowered population groups.
- b. Assurance of social security and the question of impoverishment as a function of retirement processes and employment status.
- c. Inheritance and its implications for standard of living and inequality: The prolongation of life expectancy has generated concern about the possibility of erosion in the ability of the elderly to bequeath to their offspring, the ability of the adult population to receive inheritances, the assurance of an adequate standard of living after retirement from the labor force, and the young generation's ability to continue to rely on its parents from the economic standpoint. It is important to detect factors that affect the likelihood of

receiving and giving an inheritance to the successor generation; and identify the implications of the foregoing for behavior patterns in the labor market, standard of living, and inequality.

c. Healthcare, mental health, and disabilities:

- a. Out-of-Pocket expenditure for health services at end-of-life among elderly people who died of cancer.
- b. The role of government benefits and subsidies in the labor-force re-entry of (older) persons with disabilities.
- c. Reforms in the structure of welfare- and healthcare-system funding and measurement of their implications for citizens' mobility in poverty and welfare, with emphasis on disempowered population groups (the elderly, the ill and persons with disabilities).
- d. Exploring how the welfare- and healthcare system copes with the issue of social exclusion and the foregoing of healthcare services that are covered by national health insurance.
- e. Israel's mental-health reform and its impact on inequality in the welfare- and healthcare system: mapping the development of supply of and demand for ambulatory mental-health services as a function of socioeconomic indicators.

Over the years, I have received a series of prestigious and competitive research grants, including several from the Israel Ministry of Science, Technology, and Space; the Israel National Institute for Health Policy Research; the Samuel Neeman Institute for Advanced Studies in Science and Technology, The Technion; the Minerva Center on Intersectionality in Ageing (MCIA), the Minerva Center for Interdisciplinary Study of End of Life, Joint-ESHEL and the National Insurance Institute of Israel. The total sum of these grants exceeds \$825,000. Some of the research topics described above are being funded by means of these grants. Furthermore, several research programs that I have proposed are well along in the review process.

In the next few years, I intend to present research proposals on several of these topics to the Israel Science Foundation (ISF), the Ministry of Science, Technology and Space, the German-Israeli Foundation for Scientific Research and Development (GIF), the U.S.-Israel Binational Science Foundation (BSF), and the Israel National Institute for Health Policy Research—in conjunction with the aforementioned group of leading researchers.

H2. Teaching

The main **teaching interests** in which I may make an added contribution relate to my main research experience fields:

- **Social Economics & Economics of Ageing** aspects, especially public policy in welfare, social policy, the question of government responsibility in welfare policy, inequality and poverty, and labor and healthcare trends among older adults. The relevant teaching courses that I can teach are: Issues in welfare and healthcare economics among older adults; The pension and social security system; Social security economics; Social and economic disparities; The welfare-system budgeting process; Welfare and income-assurance services; Take-up of entitlements and socioeconomic policy; Issues related to the subsidy system. In addition, I can teach about economic considerations in the activities of the Third Sector organizations, as well as statistics models.
- **Health Economics & Health Policy** aspects, especially economic considerations in the activities of healthcare, the question of government responsibility in view of past and foreseen demographic and economic changes in the health system, as well as short and long term labor trends on healthcare market. The relevant teaching courses that I can teach are: Health economics; Advanced topics in health economics; Issues in healthcare-system wage and personnel-management policy; Health policy; Economic and social considerations in healthcare-system management in states of emergency.
