I am actively engaged in international collaborations, working with researchers from Columbia University, the University of Lisbon, and Bohemia University. I serve on various academic committees and as a reviewer for several scientific journals.

Beyond my academic work, I am deeply committed to community service. I volunteer my time to deliver lectures promoting digital health literacy among seniors and youth and help soldiers and the elderly.

My future research agenda aims to advance nursing education, develop online learning methodologies, and implement community health promotion initiatives. I have a particular focus on improving online health literacy among the elderly.
