L. Summary of my Activities and Future Plans

I am a physical therapist engaging in health promotion, primarily addressing behaviour aspects of individuals (patients) and organizational alike.

During my masters' studies in occupational health I started exploring health behaviours among health professionals. Collaborating with oncology nurses, I examined the effect of an intervention program designed to improve nurses' adherence to the use of protective measures while administering chemotherapy treatment. Our findings were published in the *Israeli Oncology Nursing Journal* (2011). Another study addressed nurses' perception of their role as health educators. We compared hospital nurses with community HMO nurses and our results were published in the journal: *Health Promotion in Israel* (Oct. 2017).

Working as a physical therapist in primary care, multidisciplinary work became one of my main focuses, as I came to understand its advantages, to patients and health professionals alike. As I find this subject to be lacking among health professionals and organization in Israel, I try to promote its implementation in any way I can. Accordingly, I have initiated a new course, untended for experienced health professionals aimed at exposing them to the multidisciplinary collaboration concept and providing them with tools to enhance its implementation in their everyday work.

In addition, I take part in studies that explore health behavior issues and its' association with health organization policies. For example: what effects health professionals' trust in the health system? Aspects that are associated with adherence to Corona instructions (Social distancing among the elderly and vaccination adherence among teenagers). These studies contribute to better understanding of patients and health professionals' behaviours, enabling the planning of more effective interventions targeted to improve the population's health.

My research interests meet the areas of the subjects I teach. I am currently leading an applicable seminar on quantitative research, which relates to health promotion subjects. In addition, I teach MA Health care management students how to plan and execute health promotion interventions and how to collaborate with peers and organizations outside the health care system. Providing future and current health professionals with evidence based effective health promotion tools may help improve health behaviours and consequently, the population's health status.
