L. Summary of my Activities and Future Plans

My main field of interest is labor and demographic economics. I am also interested in political economy. My immediate research plan is to complete research on the effects of daylight on socio-economic variables (one solo-authored paper and one paper joint with Dr. Attakrit Leckchivilize), to complete the revision of the paper on the effect of immigration destination on fertility and female labor, to complete a paper on the differences between Ultra-Orthodox in the center and periphery of Israel, and to complete the paper dealing with biases in the online hotels reviews.

My future research plans include work on intergenerational mobility in Israel (joint with Yael Mishly from Shores Institute); methodological issues related to the synthetic control causal inference method; exploration of the climate change effect on aspects of the Israeli labor market, in particular, work of seniors and work accidents (joint with Rachel Palatnik);
