G. Summary of My Activities and Future Plans

I am a senior lecturer in the Department of Human Services (since 2018) and the Department of Social Work (since 2024) at The Max Stern Yezreel Valley College. I am a social worker by profession and a researcher in the field of stress-related situations in general and particularly in the organizational context. I have served on various prominent committees at the college level, e.g., Board of Governors (Senate) and Staff Organization Committee, as well as at the department level, e.g., Teaching Committee and Admissions Committee. Outside the institution, I serve as a reviewer and associate editor for academic journals and provide academic and professional counseling for organizations and associations.

One of my research interests is coping with stress in general. My work focuses on understanding how individuals navigate stressful experiences across the life span, particularly in response to significant life events, crises, and losses. I examine the personal and interpersonal resources that facilitate adaptation, well-being, and growth, and investigate risk-taking behavior, gender differences, and relational dynamics, especially among at-risk and marginalized populations. In this field, I have published 17 manuscripts and one chapter, presented 43 studies at international and national academic conferences, and was awarded four grants. Examples of my studies include: "Sexual behavior and risk-taking among adolescents: Gender, socio-economic status, and sexual status: Longitudinal analyses;" "Perpetration of violence in dating relationships among Israeli college students: Gender differences, personal and interpersonal risk factors;" and "Positivity and growth following stressful life events: Associations with psychosocial, health, and economic resources."

In this area of general coping, I have developed ten teaching courses and a research seminar. Examples of my courses include: "At-risk children," "Social deviance and adolescence," and "Sexual and social problems in Israel." In this area, I have served as a social worker in the "Integration Project" for youth who dropped out of the formal education system and in group guidance for parents of 'normative' and 'at-risk' youth. I also provide academic and professional counseling for the "ERAN" association, which provides emotional first aid for individuals in stressful situations. During the COVID-19 Pandemic, I served as a counselor for adolescents who needed someone to be there and talk to while trying to handle the crisis and social isolation. Moreover, in the aftermath of October 7, 2023, I initiated several critical interventions, e.g., serving as a

social worker in an emergency welfare system, facilitating therapeutic discourse for young adults bereaved by the Nova festival tragedy, providing sustained support to elderly couple who lost their granddaughter during her military observation duty, and co-managing the "IDF 5" civilian operations center for reserve soldiers.

In parallel with the field of general coping, my research interests include coping in the organizational context. My studies are especially conducted on healthcare professionals to understand the impact of stress on practitioners' work. The focus is on reducing burnout, promoting professionalism, and enhancing staff resilience and communication skills with work colleagues and clients/patients. In this field, I have published 12 manuscripts and two chapters, edited a book, presented 39 studies at international and national academic conferences, and was awarded seven grants (one additional grant is in "Pending" status). Examples of my studies include: "Burnout, social support, and coping at work among social workers, nurses, and psychologists: The role of challenge/control appraisals;" "The associations between resilience, self-care, and burnout among medical students;" "The role of occupational coping self-efficacy in determining the effectiveness of social sharing following patient aggression: A longitudinal study among healthcare workers."

In the organizational coping area, I have developed a teaching course, a workshop, and a research seminar: "Deviant behavior in the workplace," "Skills of practicum," and "Interpersonal communication in service organizations," respectively. In this area, I provide academic and professional counseling for various organization managers and student instructors.

Current-Future Projects

These days, I am working on several studies in the context of October 7, 2023 events:

- A mixed-methods study developing A GAI-driven simulator system for breaking bad news and evaluating healthcare and welfare Professionals' competency and well-being.
- A quantitative longitudinal study examining the associations between personal resources, stress perception, coping strategies, and emotional states.
- A qualitative study exploring civil and military professionals' experiences while delivering death notifications, focusing on protocol improvements.
- A quantitative study examining personal resources, burnout, and turnover intentions among spouses of reserve soldiers.
